Saint Matthias

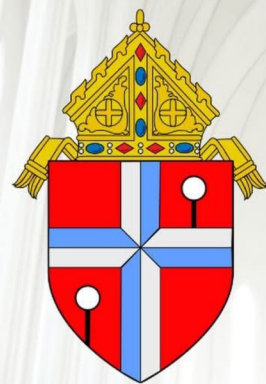
Feast

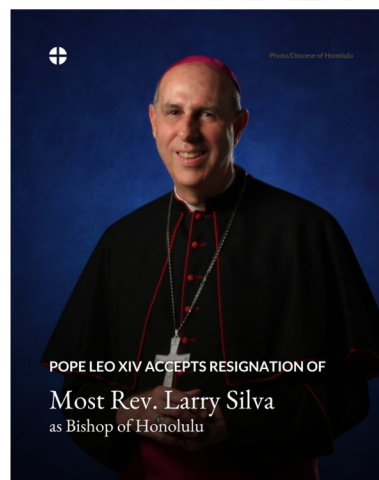
Bishop-Elect Rev. Michael Castori, SJ

Reflection on the Gospel

In today’s gospel passage from John, Jesus reminds his disciples of keeping his commandments and the rewards of it. Such actions are done out of love, as such Jesus will ask his Father for another *Advocate* to be with us always. Namely the *Third Person* of the Trinity, the *Holy Spirit*.

Out of subject matters of each person of the Trinity, the *Holy Spirit* has the least number of known publications. However, the Spirit’s influence is still being witnessed and experienced. It is through the Spirit, that we are able to experience Jesus’ love for us, an experience that goes beyond time itself. Without our dependency on the Holy Spirit, the Church would have fallen a long time ago.

Jesus interceding for us to the Father, to allow the Holy Spirit to guide us, is already a great gift. However, Jesus reminds us that he will come to each and one of us, to not leave us as orphans (John 14:18). That is how great Jesus’ love for us, even though he has ascended to his Father’s side. It is beyond human comprehension of how much love humanity continues to receive. To have been created, cared for, and guided.

Humanity can be careless, reckless, and/or misguided; however, Jesus still holds out his hand for us. For us to choose and grasp it, to become what God had intended each and every one of us to be. Let us pray for one another and be the Jesus to the people we meet in our lives.

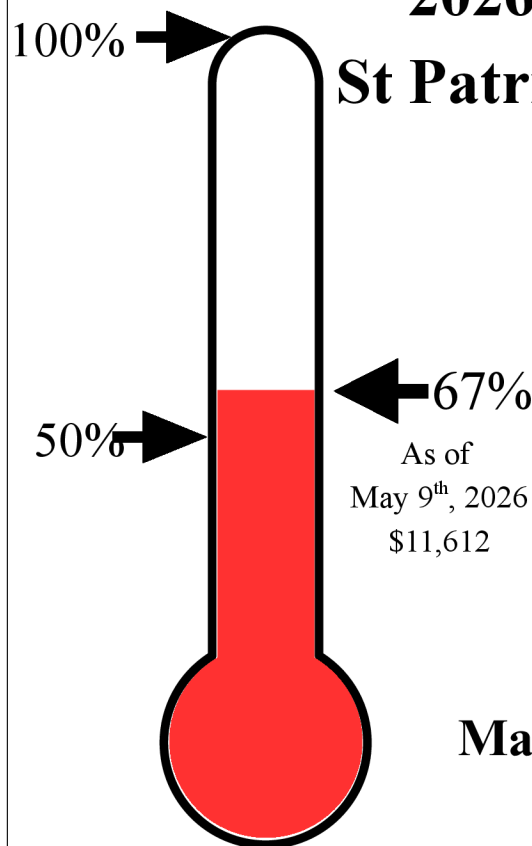

Faith in Action

“And What I Have Failed to Do”

“I confess... in what I have done and in what I have failed to do.”

Many of us understand sin as doing something wrong. In the Confiteor, the Church reminds us that we sin not only by what we do, but also by the good we fail to do. Sometimes we think being a good Catholic simply means avoiding serious sin, attending Mass on Sundays, and fulfilling our obligations. These things matter deeply. But Jesus calls us beyond obligation alone.

Throughout the Gospel, Christ asks His followers to actively love:

to forgive,
to encourage,
to help the poor,
to comfort the lonely,
to welcome others,
to serve quietly,
and to care for one another as members of one family.

The words “what I have failed to do” invite us to examine not only our actions, but also the opportunities for love we may have ignored.

Did I notice someone struggling and remain silent?
Did I withhold kindness?
Did I avoid helping because it was inconvenient?
Did I fail to pray for others?
Did I choose comfort over compassion?

Holiness is not only avoiding evil. It is choosing love.
